



FOUNTAINS AND ART

From the ferry terminal take the steps down to Harborside Fountain Park or visit the Louis Mentor Boardwalk and climb the Harborside Steps for more fountains. From Washington Ave, go west on 1st St to Pacific Ave and visit PSNS Memorial Plaza Park. Continue your walk around Bremerton – public art is located throughout the downtown streets.

EVERGREEN ROTARY PARK

Enjoy a family and pet friendly park complete with walking path, accessible playground, picnic shelters, boat ramp and waterfront access. From the ferry terminal, go west on 1st St to Pacific Ave. Continue north to the south entrance of Evergreen Rotary Park.

BRIDGE-TO-BRIDGE

Take in the sights and sounds of Bremerton as you cross the Warren Ave and Manette Bridges. From the ferry terminal, go west on 1st St to Pacific Ave. Follow Pacific Ave north to Evergreen Rotary Park. Continue north to Park Ave. Take a left on 17th St and right on Warren Ave. Cross the Warren Ave Bridge. Take the steps down to Lebo Blvd at the north end of the bridge, go left. Follow Lebo Blvd and take a right on Wheaton Way. Continue south to the Manette Bridge. Cross the bridge and take a left on Washington Ave, continue to the ferry terminal.

BREMERTON MARINA BREAKWATER

From the ferry terminal take the steps down to the Louis Mentor Boardwalk to the Bremerton Marina Breakwater and USS Turner Joy. The Breakwater is open to the public from 7am to 10pm and is home to the Lone Sailor Statue.



the harborside district

Located at 100 Washington Avenue next to the ferry terminal, Bremerton Harborside takes in the beautiful Bremerton waterfront. We invite you to explore the public parks, fountains and art, while enjoying the district's restaurants, museums, shops and tourist attractions.

HARBORSIDE FOUNTAIN PARK – 251 1st St
One of the Puget Sound region's most impressive public spaces. Located on the waterfront, just steps away from the Kitsap Conference Center and the Bremerton-Seattle ferry terminal, the park features five large copper-ringed fountains, wading pools and lush landscaping.

USS TURNER JOY – 300 Washington Beach Ave, 360-792-2457
A restored Vietnam era destroyer - the first permanent, and publicly accessible, Naval heritage and educational ship attraction in the Pacific Northwest. The museum ship and memorial honors not only the men and women of our modern US Navy, but also recognizes the accomplishment of those who help build and maintain the Navy's ships.

PUGET SOUND NAVY MUSEUM – 251 1st St, 360-479-7447
Located in historic Building 50, this museum offers an up-close look at life on the sea, important moments for the Navy in Puget Sound and the history of the Naval Shipyard. Visitors can explore the naval history of the region and experience life as a sailor through exhibits about the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard, the USS John C Stennis, and much more. Admission is free.

PSNS MEMORIAL PLAZA – Pacific Ave & Burwell St
Wander among beautiful rock and water sculptures while learning about the long history between the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard (PSNS) and Bremerton. Three plazas, each with pool ponds, feature an era in shipyard history - Women Workers of World War I, the shipyard during World War II and today's shipyard workers.

KITSAP CONFERENCE CENTER – 100 Washington Ave, 360-377-3785
Just a short ferry ride from Seattle. Offering an unsurpassed standard of excellence for your meetings, conferences, trade shows, social events, reunions, and weddings. ferry, bus, taxi & parking services

Hourly and all-day covered parking is located under the Hampton Inn. Parking is also available at various downtown lots. Free parking can be found along downtown streets in 30 minutes; 1, 2 and 3 hour increments. The Transportation Center has information about Washington State Ferries, Kitsap Transit foot ferry, bus and taxi services.

worth visiting

Wish to explore other areas of Bremerton? If transportation allows, consider making the following attractions your destination. All are located within a 15 to 30 minute drive from the downtown area.

GOLD MOUNTAIN GOLF COURSE – 263 W Belfair Valley Rd, 360-415-5432
Gold Mountain Golf Course includes two 18-hole championship golf courses: the Cascade Course and the Olympic Course. Dramatically sculpted in the Pacific Northwest wilderness habitat, the Olympic Course has earned numerous awards and taken its place as one of America's finest public golf facilities.

LIONS PARK – 251 Lebo Blvd, 360-473-5305
Lions Park offers 0.9 mile of walking path with views of Mt. Rainier and the Olympic Mountains. Lions Park has restrooms, drinking water, two lighted softball fields, two playgrounds, outdoor basketball, tennis courts, two picnic shelters and plenty of waterfront green space for events and activities. Parking is available in three lots, each accessed off of Lebo Blvd in East Bremerton.

DISC GOLF AT NAD PARK – 6002 Kitsap Way, 360-473-5305
The course at NAD Park winds through more than 20 acres of forest, includes a F-8 Crusader airplane and offers the public a great disc golf experience amid a beautiful Northwest location. The course has been designed to offer a little something for everyone. It will challenge the most advanced golfer and give the beginner a fabulous course for learning.

KITSAP 9/11 MEMORIAL – 1300 Highland Avenue, kitsap911memorial.org
The Kitsap 9/11 Memorial Project is dedicated to the men, women and children who lost their lives; those brave people who gave their lives and the Heroes that responded to the emergency on September 11, 2001. Touch 5,000 pounds of steel pulled from New York's World Trade Center, feel limestone taken from the damaged Pentagon and read stories of the four destroyed airliners.

EASTPARK & MADRONA TRAILS – Magnuson & Homer Jones, 360-473-5305
Eastpark is home to three recreation facilities (Glenn Jarstad Aquatic Center, YMCA, and Bremerton Ice Arena), the Bremerton Skatepark, 17.5 acres of open grass space (includes play toy, BBQs, picnic tables and park benches) and 15.5 acres of surrounding trail lands in Madrona Trails.

Bremerton's quality of life is what makes this city—and our visitors—smile. Make Bremerton your destination and see for yourself!

A one hour ferry ride from downtown Seattle, Bremerton is truly a beautiful city where guests enjoy the downtown Harborside area. It includes Kitsap Conference Center, two hotels, fine dining, coffee shops, cafes and the Port of Bremerton Marina with 220 permanent slips and 100 for visiting boaters.

We invite you to enjoy a stroll through the Arts District, Bremerton Naval Museum, USS Turner Joy, Boardwalk, Harborside Fountain Park and PSNS Memorial Plaza all located near the ferry terminal. Take a short walk across the Manette Bridge for more cafes and shopping. A few blocks north of downtown is the beautiful Evergreen Rotary Park featuring the 9/11 Memorial. Gold Mountain Golf Course includes two 18 hole championship courses and the now popular Disc Golf Course in NAD Park. Our diversity has rewarded Bremerton with a thriving artistic and cultural community. Bremerton has nine unique neighborhoods with new affordable housing, excellent schools, 35 parks, and many recreation programs. It will be easy to see why people are experiencing Bremerton and what a great place it is to live, work, and play.
