


WHAT IS ANNEXATION

Annexation is the process by which cities extend their municipal services, regulations, voting privileges, and taxing authority to new territory.

BENEFITS OF ANNEXATION

- Access to City water and sewer service without surcharges
- Increased local government representation - your neighbors could be your elected representatives
- Tax dollars will be retained in your localized area
- Land value protection through the City's Comprehensive Plan and development regulations
- Connects communities that are separated only by jurisdictional lines
- Creates more efficiency in providing services from the city

ANNEXATION PROCESS

For annexation to occur a petition must be signed by the owners representing at least 75% of the assessed valuation of the proposed annexation area. Once this has been achieved, the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider public testimony and decide whether to approve the annexation. Following the public hearing City Council must enact an ordinance to annex the area.

STUDY PROCESS

The City is conducting a study to determine annexation feasibility and your input is very important to us. No annexation is currently proposed or underway. City staff is working on a cost benefit analysis to provide you with as much information as possible. Staff plans to have more detailed information provided for you at the upcoming neighborhood meetings. Please come and get involved in this study and help us understand your community.
