Dear neighbor,

Someone in the neighborhood has been setting off fireworks. The only day fireworks are legal is July 4.

We are not allowed to set off fireworks on any other day of the year—only July 4th from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. In addition, fireworks use is prohibited by City Code in all Bremerton's Parks. City parks close at dusk.

Think about your neighbors. They have animals who go crazy with sudden noises, and the loud booms disturb people as well.

We appreciate your cooperation with our City's laws, our neighbors, and our community in keeping Bremerton safe and peaceful.

BMC 9.48.40 (a) states, "No person shall use or explode any fireworks within the City except from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 4th of any year or as part of a public display authorized pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington and this chapter. It shall not be legal to use or discharge fireworks at any other time..."
