ABOUT THE BREMERTON ARTS COMMISSION

The Bremerton Arts Commission is committed to celebrating and encouraging the arts, and enriching the environment and experiences of our community. Funded by 1% for the arts, the Arts Commission supports opportunities to celebrate the City's multi-cultural and diverse character. The Arts Commission wishes to incorporate public art in places that will have the greatest visual impact, provide opportunities for public interaction and reach citizens who may not otherwise experience the arts.

SUBMISSIONS

The City of Bremerton Arts Commission is pleased to announce a call for emerging and professional artists working in all mediums, styles and schools of thought. The Commission is working with Washington State Ferries to create a gallery to be placed on the new Ferry Chimacum featuring up to 16 pieces of contemporary work that reflects the creativity of local artists. Images should provide a positive impression and lasting memory for citizens and visitors.

SELECTION

Artists are invited to submit digital images of their artwork to be displayed on the Chimacum due to set sail Spring 2017. Up to 16 works will be selected by the Arts Commission.

IMPORTANT DATES

Entries Due: **November 1st, 2016**
Notice of Acceptance: **December 15th, 2016**

STIPEND AWARD

Artist will receive a \$200 stipend for selected artwork.

ELIGIBILITY

You must live in Kitsap, Mason, Peirce, or Jefferson County for your submission to be considered. Proof of residency will be requested if selected.

IMAGE REQUIREMENTS & SUBMISSION DETAILS

File size specifications: Native, uncompressed files (gif, jpg, jpeg, pdf) 300 dpi minimum
Pixels must be a minimum of 1600 x 2400 and a maximum of 4800 x 7200.

Example of title format: LastnameFirstnameTitle.pdf

Number of submissions: Each artist is invited to submit **2 images**.

Submissions must include:

In the “Subject” box: Artist Name and Title(s) of their work

(ex. John Smith, “Ferry Art 1” & “Ferry Art 2”)

In the “Message” box: Artist Contact Information (Address and Phone)

Important note: Artists must retain the copyright for images that are submitted.

FRAMING

Artists are only to provide a digital file of their work. The City will be responsible for printing, matting and framing. The images will be printed to a 16” x 22” size with a 3” off white matting. The work will be in a black frame measuring 22” x 28”.

USE RIGHTS: Each artist retains all copyrights to their own images. Artist’s recognition is provided with any use. By submission for jurying, artist whose submissions are chosen for the exhibition grant the City of Bremerton and Washington State Department of Transportation the right to use their images for the purpose of promoting the artist, promoting the City of Bremerton, and promoting the Transportation Department. Promotions and images may also be placed on social networks with artist credit. Artists grant the use of their image as stated without further contact or compensation from the City of Bremerton.
